It is also one of the leading governing bodies across all sport in the UK, with over 43,000 members who have access to a calendar of well over 3,500 events spread across 6 cycle sport disciplines. We now have an opportunity for an enthusiastic, appropriately qualified individual to join us as a Regional Events Officer for the South Region.

The Role

This is an exciting position forming part of an established Regional team playing a key role in, developing the Cycle Sport Events programme in the Region and across the country, creating more events and participation opportunities in the lead up to London 2012 and beyond.

We require a highly motivated individual to work as part of this team to manage and co-ordinate the planning and implementation of a Cycle Sport Events programme within the Region and Inter Regionally. The focus of the Regional Events Officer role is to increase the quantity and quality of participation opportunities across a range of Cycle Sport disciplines resulting in increased participation and satisfaction levels among participants, volunteers and officials. The Cycle Sport Events programme is at the heart of British Cycling and these posts will help us transform the future landscape of the sport.

Interested?

You will need to demonstrate:

- Understanding of competitive and non competitive cycling across all disciplines with the ability and enthusiasm to drive the sport forward.
- Experience of working with voluntary and statutory sectors and community groups.
- Experience of working with different organisations and people at a variety of levels
- Ability to work remotely: travelling between sites within a large region.

It goes without saying that excellent interpersonal and communication skills along with strong planning and organisational skills are essential. The post holder must either live within, be willing to relocate to an area within or reside within travelling distance of the boundaries of the British Cycling South Region (Dorset, Hampshire, Wiltshire, Avon, Gloucestershire and Isle of Wight).

All of our permanent employees are provided with Gold Membership of British Cycling. Our hours of work are 37.5 per week, although weekend and evening work will sometimes be required.
